<u>A message from Mrs. Brimson</u>

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you very much for all of your continued support for the school this week during the recent Ofsted inspection. The children conducted themselves very well throughout the inspection and had many opportunities to talk to the inspection team about their learning here at the school. More information about the inspection will be released later this month.

On Thursday, a representative from Edukids came into school to deliver an assembly about a child from Uganda called Daniel. This is a longstanding link within the school and we hope to continue this work further through fundraising activities and learning in class.

Educational Mental Health Support

Ness Newman, Educational Mental Health Practitioner (EMHP for short!), will be based at Bratton Fleming Community Primary School on a Friday morning each week commencing next **Friday 11th November at 9:00am**, when she will be holding a coffee morning for parents in the school hall. Ness will give an introduction to children's mental health and ways you can support your own child's mental health. She will discuss her role and ways in which she can support if you have any concerns over your child's mental health.

Time in school will be split between helping Bratton Fleming Primary to develop a whole school approach to mental health, and working directly with children.

The 'Whole School Approach' means thinking about how every part of school life – people, buildings, timetables and parents and carers, can work together to develop a mentally healthy place to learn and work; one that promotes positive wellbeing and where students are supported to be happy, resilient, and healthy young people. Ness will also be working with parents in 1:1 or group sessions to support the mental health needs of their children.
